Band Hierarchy of Discipline

The following is the band hierarchy to be used in most discipline cases. This is the fall version to be used out of doors. A spring version which can be used in class will also be developed. Students and parents should understand that unsatisfactory behavior will also have a negative effect on the student's grade.

Summer & Fall

If you are called up at break or after rehearsal, the following levels of discipline apply:

1st Offense – 25 push-ups during break/after rehearsal

2nd Offense- 2 laps during break/after rehearsal

3rd Offense – 4 laps during break/after rehearsal and **one write-up to the school administration for behavior.**

(3 call-ups during break or after rehearsal = one write up)

1st Write-up- Sit out of 1 show/assist guard and/or pit.

2nd Write-up – Sit out of 1 show/assist guard and/or pit.

3rd Write-up- Taken out of band

The following offenses constitute call-ups at break or after rehearsal:

Absence due to job. Because of the necessity of having everyone at all rehearsals, this offense counts as two (2) call-ups.

Bus Behavior Problems

Classroom Disruption

Cell Phone, Beeper, or Pager -- Possession during rehearsals or performances

– School policy applies

Eating, drinking, gum chewing – in the band room or at rehearsals.

Failure to have necessary equipment (horn, drill charts, music, accessories, etc.)

- Because of the necessity of having everything needed at rehearsal, this offense counts as two (2) call-ups.

Failure to properly store instruments, equipment, or music, etc.

Failure to perform freshman duties

Horseplay

2 Unexcused Tardies = 1 call-up

Possession of devices such as radio, CD, tape player, games

Public Display of Affection

2nd Offense – Separation and notification of parents

Stands Behavior

Uniform Infraction

The following offenses constitute an immediate write-up to school administration
(This results in sitting out of 1 show/assist guard and/or pit.

Destroying, Defacing School/Personal Property- restitution for damages as well as referral.
A 2nd offense will result in removal from the band program.

Disrespectful Behavior- (uncooperative, rude behavior which is disruptive to the orderly process of classroom activities).

Failure to follow the band check-out procedure following a performance

Failure to perform disciplinary action.

Possession of or use of fireworks including smoke/stink bombs
